### LOCATION 1



Bats and wickets lie on the lawn where our trail today begins,  
Join Woodstock Road and head south past the school and inns.

Soon you'll spot a church and there you'll lean to the left,  
Down the road you'll walk and peek at doors carved with deft.

This 'Beech' farm fostered lights and skills in many ways:  
Can you see the speed bumps? With shiny paint aglaze!

The tip of this road hosts a home for elderly men and women,
